New Zealand Nature Fund campaign

The NZ Nature Fund is continuing to champion the project and raise funds to support the restoration of Kawau Island. An additional \$200,000 was received towards the end of 2024, taking total donations to the project to over \$700,000 to date, and bringing the fund closer to its \$2 million fundraising target.
